3.3 Footpaths. Brian Hunter had spoken to Tony Turner re overgrown footpaths on Normanby Rise, and since then a similar problem had developed along Mulberry Road. BH had spoken to District Councillor Bernard Theobald who had agreed to look into the matter. Hope to cut back to 3'6"

3.4 Sewage works. Anglian Water had renewed one sewage pump but the system has become noisy again. Apparently the second pump now needs renewing. Anglian Water has suggested a site visit when convenient.

4.1 Footpath 94 (church to plantation) difficult to make out, obstructed and electric fences in the way
