1. Minutes of May meeting

2. Matters Arising

The kerb stone on Bristows corner has been replaced but not the litter bin.

A cheque for £125 has been donated towards the upkeep of St Mary's Churchyard.

3. Highways

4. Police Report

The old cricket hut is to be dismantled and plans for a new pavilion were discussed.

The Trees for Parishes was discussed and it was agreed to plant a further 15 trees on the side of the playing field.
